PERSONNEL:

Town Clerk, Arrah Richards has many copies of The Register in her office. The Town has subscribed to The Register and the article comes out once a week along with a quarterly booklet. This is taking up a lot of space in her office and this information can be accessed online. The board is okay with unsubscribing from The Register and viewing the contents online instead. The Clerk's Office received \$3.1 million in tax payments for the town and county during the month of January, 62 dog licenses, 243 mobile home park renewals, and completed 78 certified birth/death certificates. The Clerk has also switched telephone services saving approximately \$250 per month on the Central Phone System account. Due to low internet quality at the time of switchover and the new phone service using VoiP, the Town Highway is unable to switch over to the new phone service.

Highway Superintendent Fred Schweiger is wondering where the Town is on paying retro for the highway men. Supervisor Cary said they are looking into the financial and legal part of the retro. Attorney Middaugh said she should have some idea in the next 30-60 days.
